The vendor must enclose with this form all sales invoices (this term includes all sales documents).

If the purchaser is an Indian band or a band-empowered entity, the vendor must complete this form and obtain and retain certification that the property is being acquired by such a purchaser. If the band-empowered entity is a legal person, the certification must also confirm that the property is being purchased for band management activities.

#### Important

If the property is delivered to the reserve by the **vendor's agent** (that is, by an individual or a business contracted by the vendor to make deliveries), the vendor must retain

- the Certificate of Indian Status card number or the certification issued by the Indian band or the band-empowered entity; and
- proof of delivery to the reserve, such as a **waybill**, a **freight bill** or a **postal receipt** showing an address on the reserve.
